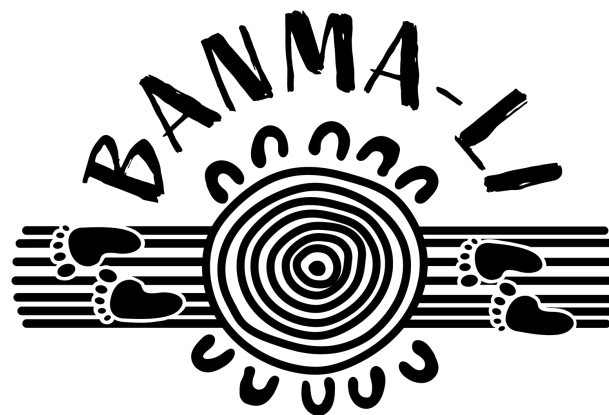




ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COUNTRY

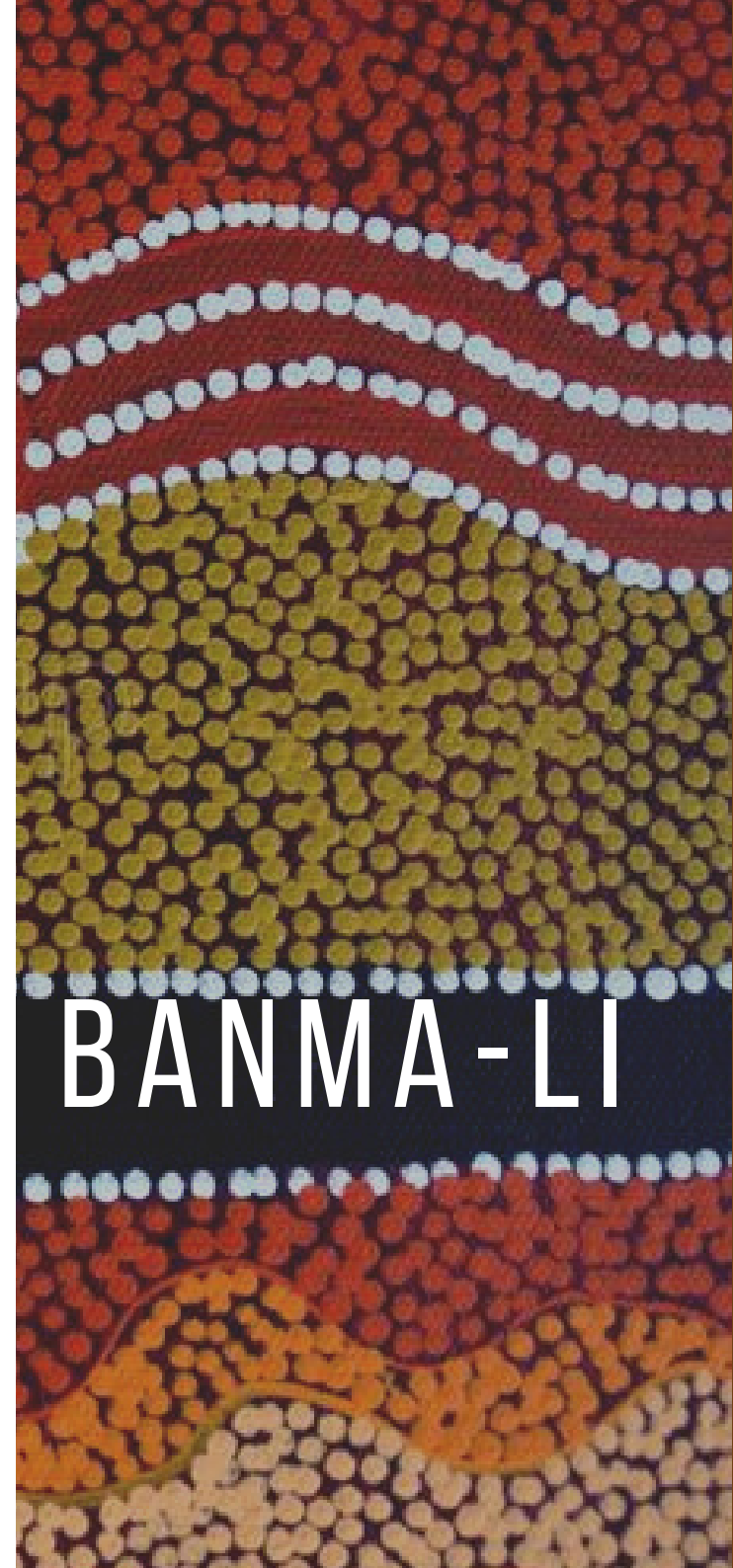

WHAT IS CHONIC DISEASE

a chronic disease is a health condition that keeps coming back or last longer than 6 months

WHAT IS INTEGRATED TEAM CARE?

Integrated Team Care (ITC) program is funded by Western NSW Primary Health Network (WNSWPHN) and the program aims to improve health outcomes for Aboriginal people living within Western NSW with chronic conditions through care coordination, multidisciplinary care and improve access to culturally appropriate mainstream primary care services

WHAT IS A CARE PLAN

A GP Management Plan (GPMP) can help people with chronic medical conditions by providing an organised approach to care.

HOW IS BANMA-LI ACCESSED?

STEP ONE

GP completes (715) ATSI health check

STEP TWO

GP completes (721, 723) GP management plan

STEP THREE

GP assesses patients needs for services and will refer patient to Banma-li to organise services

STEP FOUR

Referral accepted, worker will follow up with patient and GP arranging services

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Aboriginal and/or Torres Islander patients who reside within the Western NSW PHN region (we require confirmation of Aboriginality)

Diagnosed with one of the following chronic conditions;

- Diabetes and eye related conditions
- Cardiovascular
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Chronic respiratory Disease
- Cancer
- Liver Disease

Have a ATSI health check and GP management plan completed by their usual treating doctor
Exceptional circumstances referrals will be considered on a case by case basis

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- This program is for planned scheduled care
- We are not set up to address crisis/urgent care
- We require a minimum 72 hours notice to review, assess and respond to referrals and organise services
- EPC's should be utilised first before referring to Banma-li
- Patients living in aged care facilities are not eligible for services

CONSENT

Consent must be given at all times to participate in the ITC Program

SERVICES INCLUDE

- TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION TO ATTEND HEALTH APPOINTMENTS
- CONSULTATION FEES WITH HEALTH APPOINTMENTS E.G. DIAGNOSTIC TESTS
- MEDICAL FOOTWEAR FITTED AND PERSCRIBED BY PODIATRIST
- ASSISTIVE BREATHING EQUIPMENT E.G. ASTHMA SPACER, CPAP, NEBULISERS
- BLOOD GLUCOSE MONITORING EQUIPMENT
- MOBILITY AIDS E.G. CRUTCHES, WALKING FRAME, SHOWER CHAIR, NON-ELECTRIC WHEELCHAIR

NOTE: MOBILITY AIDS MUST BE PERSCRIBED BY APPROVED GPS, SPECIALISTS OR ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

- SERVICES NOT INCLUDED IN CAREPLAN
- DENTAL APPOINTMENTS OR DENTAL WORK
- OPERATIONS
- MEDICATIONS
- SERVICES AVAILABLE THROUGH OTHER PROGRAMS
- CONTINUOUS GLUCOSE MONITORING DEVICES E.G. CGM DEVICES
